FORM OF BEQUEST

(a) Subject to subclause (b) of this clause, I GIVE the sum of \$..... to QUAKER SERVICE AUSTRALIA INCORPORATED of 119 Devonshire Street, Surry Hills NSW (hereafter called “QSA”).

(b) If at the date of my death QSA has been wound up or has otherwise ceased to serve as the development aid agency of Religious Society of Friends (Quakers) in Australia Incorporated, then I GIVE the amount of this bequest to such other association, committee or body (whether incorporated or unincorporated) as is nominated in writing by the Presiding Clerk for the time being of Religious Society of Friends (Quakers) in Australia Incorporated to be serving as such agency at that date and in that event reference in the following provisions of this clause to QSA shall mean the agency so nominated.

(c) IT IS MY WISH that the sum bequeathed to QSA shall, so far as is reasonably practicable (as to which QSA shall be the sole judge), be used by it (*Here set out the use of the bequest required by the testator, if any, such as:*

- *For such purposes as it decides*
- *For overseas aid projects*
- *For Australian Aboriginal Concerns projects*
- *For its projects in (specify a country). QSA may, at its discretion, redirect the money to an alternative country should there be no likelihood of future projects in that nominated country*
- *Should the nominated project have been completed or no longer exist, the money should be directed to another project at QSA’s discretion*

(d) The receipt of the Treasurer for the time being of QSA shall be a sufficient discharge to my executor for any money paid to QSA under this clause. My executor shall not be responsible for supervising the use of any such money by QSA.
